



ACCOMMODATED LEARNING ACADEMY UNIFORM POLICY - GIRLS

Accommodated Learning Academy has a required uniform. Student clothing must be conservative, neat, clean, pressed, and properly fitted.

All uniform items are to be purchased from Ivy School Uniforms in Colleyville.

Students who are enrolled at ALA must be uniform policy compliant while on campus during the entire school day (8:30 am – 3:15 pm).

Students who do not follow the guidelines for uniform policy will be subject to disciplinary action and/or forfeiture of privileges. ALA administration reserves the right to determine the appropriateness of all clothing worn at school and school functions.

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday



Top- Red or blue polo, tucked in.

Bottom- Khaki or navy shorts, skirts, or pants.

Skirts/shorts must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee.

Pants/Shorts must be worn with a black, navy, or brown belt.

Dress- Red polo dress.

Wednesday



Top/Bottom- Red polo, tucked in, with plaid skirt.

Dress- Plaid jumper with long sleeve or short sleeve blouse.

Shoes- Closed-toe shoes of any style.

Accessories/Jewelry- You may have no more than 2 earrings per ear at any one time. Earrings are not permitted on any other part of the body. Any other accessory is permissible so long as it does not create a distraction for your student or the students around them.

Sweatshirts/Sweaters- ALA fleece jackets are permitted within the building year-round. Plain, non-logo, jackets are permitted for wear outside of the building during winter weather.
